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




Health Equity

 - Equitable Delivery of Gov't Benefits & Equitable Opportunities
 - Equitable Data Working Group

Biden-Harris Administration Actions for Health Equity

- E.O. **13995**-Ensuring an Equitable Pandemic Response & Recovery
 - Health Equity Task Force
- E.O. **14009**-Strengthening Medicaid & the Affordable Care Act
 - Special Enrollment Period for Marketplace
 - Increased access to ACA
- HBCU support: \$5.8B + \$2.7B
- CMS: expanded funding for medical residency positions
- CMS: Medicaid post-partum coverage extension

Advancing Effective, Accountable Policing and Criminal Justice Practices to Enhance Public Trust and Public Safety

- E.O. 14074– May 25, 2022
 - Banning chokeholds and carotid restraints
 - Restricting no-knock entries
 - Sentencing reduction in appropriate cases
 - Investigating and prosecuting civil rights violations
 - Timely and consistent discipline for use of deadly force
 - Anti-bias training & guidance; MH Crisis training
 - Enhancing re-entry
 - Strengthening officer recruitment, hiring, promotion & retention



SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH

"Conditions in the places" where people live, learn, work, and play that affect a wide range of health and quality-of-life risks and outcomes"

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SDOH DEFINED

- Social **Determinants** of Health
- Social **Drivers** of Health
- Health-Related Social Needs (HRSN)
 - Neighborhood & Built Environment (Housing, Transportation, Safety, Home Modifications)
 - Food/Nutrition
 - Education
 - Community & Social Context
 - Financial Stability (Employment, Income)
 - Language Access

Though generally assessed individually, SDOH is truly a community-level issue and should be addressed as such

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Determinants of Health Genes & Biology, 10% Physical Environment, 10% Social & Economical Factors, 40% Clinical Care, 10% Health Behaviors, 30% 18

White House Conference on Hunger, Nutrition and Health

- Goal: end hunger, increase healthy eating & physical activity by 2030
- Food insecurity and diet-related diseases
- Local, State, Tribal & territorial governments, agriculture, philanthropy, & academia
 - Improve access and affordability
 - Integrate nutrition and health
 - Empower consumers to make & have access to healthy choices
 - Support physical activity for all
 - Enhance nutrition & food security research

WHITE HOUSE SDOH ACTION PLAN

- Whole-of-Government approach to link hospital systems, public health and social services
- 35 Federal Agencies and Departments, 22 external stakeholder organizations
- Potential policy levers to address Social Determinants of Health
 - *through blending and braiding* of funds in order to create conditions that optimize health and create healthy and resilient communities
 - Through support for Backbone Organizations
 - through alignment of data use and privacy policies
